ENTRY FEES:

- The TPA & IA is required to pay GST on all entry fees received. **All** entry fees stated in the schedule **includes GST**.
- **All** exhibitors must pay the GST inclusive entry fees whether they are registered for GST purposes or not.
- Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes may be able to claim a credit for GST paid. We recommend you check with your Financial Advisor or the Australian Taxation Office. To assist with any claim for credit we will forward at the exhibitors request a **Tax Invoice/Receipt** for the total entry fees received including GST.

SPONSORSHIP:

- The Association is required to pay GST on sponsorship monies received.
- Sponsorship monies stated in the front of the schedule includes GST paid.

1. Bush House, Orchid & Bonsai nominations close 12noon Wednesday 2nd July 2025
Entries to be benched by 7:00pm Thursday 3rd July 2025 for judging to commence at 9.00am Friday 4th July 2025 No late Entries accepted.

No leaf shine to be used on Bush House plants and only 1 plant type per pot, pot size no more than 250mm in diameter and Baskets shall not exceed 350mm in diameter. Entries will be accepted between 1.00pm and 7.00pm Thursday 3rd July
Presentation of plants is important.

2. Cut Flowers, Floral Art & Juniors to be nominated by 12noon Thursday 3rd July 2025.
Entries to be benched by 8.30am on Friday 4th July 2025 for judging at 9.00am Friday 4th July 2025. Late Entries, which must be completed on the correct Entry Form, will be permitted only for Cut Flowers if another entry has already been made, prior to the nomination close date and must be submitted by 8.30am Friday 4th July 2025. Please have these on entry form for the stewards. **Exhibitors to supply their own containers.** Cut means more than 1 flower. Stem means 1 flower.

3. Entry for exhibitors to the Showgrounds to deliver their pieces for judging will only be permitted through the Besser/Hanson Gate (behind the main grandstand located approx. halfway along the Townsville showgrounds on the Ingham Service Rd) between 1:00pm and 7:00pm on Thursday 3rd July and 6:30am – 8:30am Friday 4th July
CARS ARE ONLY ALLOWED ON THE TOWNSVILLE SHOWGROUNDS ON Thursday 3rd July from 1:00pm to 7:00pm and Friday 4th July from 6.30am to 8.30am and Tuesday 8th July from 8:00am
4. **All floriculture exhibits to remain on display for the duration of the 2025 Townsville Show. Exhibits can be taken from the grounds via the Hanson/Besser Gate on Tuesday 8th July 2025 from 8.00am until 1:00pm**
5. “FOR SALE” CARDS OR NOTICES are not allowed on exhibits. No exhibit will be offered “For Sale” without the approval of the Association’s Secretary.
6. Prize Money will be deposited into each winner’s nominated bank account, entrants should ensure they have provided correct bank details on their entry/nomination form upon submission. If an entrant would prefer to collect their prize money in Cash or if they are collecting vouchers or trophies, these will be available for collection from the Administration Office from Monday 14th July until Friday 25th July 2025, during the hours of 9:00am to 4:00pm. If an exhibitor is unable to collect their prize during this period, they **MUST** contact the Townsville Show office to make alternate arrangements, **failure to provide bank details/collect prize money/ make alternate arrangements with the Admin Office during the nominated period may result in prize/prize money being forfeited.**
