IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- **ALL PRINTS in Classes 1-10 MUST BE no smaller than 20x25cm or no larger than 25x30cm in either portrait or landscape format, FLUSH MOUNTED ONTO BOARD & LABELED CLEARLY AS PER CONDITIONS OF ENTRY ON BACK/REVERSE SIDE. Prints in the Student Classes 11 and 12 should have a minimum size of 12x18 cm, or no larger than 15x20 cm, in portrait or landscape format.**

Flush mounting – Please ensure prints are properly adhered to thick card or mounting board the same size as the photo.

**** All prints not in the above-mentioned format will be disqualified****

ENTRY FEES:

- The TPA & IA is required to pay GST on all entry fees received. **All** entry fees stated in the schedules **include GST**.
- **All** exhibitors must pay the GST inclusive entry fees whether they are registered for GST purposes or not registered.
- Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes may be able to claim a credit for GST paid. We recommend you check with your Financial Advisor or the Australian Taxation Office. To assist with any claim for credit we will forward at the exhibitor's request a **Tax Invoice/Receipt** for the total entry fees received including GST.
- Primary & Secondary school aged children are exempt from paying entry & admin fees into both Student classes; Primary & Secondary. However, if a primary or secondary student wishes to enter into a class not previously mentioned, they are permitted to pay entry & admin fees as a normal exhibitor.

SPONSORSHIP:

- The Association is required to pay GST on sponsorship monies received.
- Sponsorship monies stated in the front of the schedule includes GST paid.
- Sponsors who are registered for GST purposes may be able to claim a credit for GST paid. We recommend sponsors check with their Financial Advisor or the Australian Taxation Office. We will issue a Tax Invoice to all sponsors.

PRIZE MONEY:

- Prize money stated in the schedule excludes GST. GST will be added to the prize money for exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes and provide our Association with a Recipient Generated Tax Invoice. Townsville Pastoral Agricultural & Industrial Association will not issue tax invoices in respect of prizes. Some prizes may be in the form of vouchers or prizes from Sponsors. Cash will not be given out instead of prizes. Please inform the Townsville Pastoral Agricultural & Industrial Association that you are registered when nominating and notify TPA & IA again, if you cease to be registered.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Photographs must be submitted into the Showgrounds Office no later than **4pm Friday 2nd June 2023**.
2. The competition is open to all photographers.
3. The onus is on the entrant to package photos adequately for mailing and no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.
4. Accepting the current Copyright Laws are somewhat shaky, however the Association asks permission to use the overall image. This can be afforded by signing or otherwise, the particular section on the entry form.
5. Prints exhibited in previous Townsville Shows are ineligible, therefore work should be of current nature and not previously shown in this competition.
6. All photos must be taken by the exhibitor, computer-based reproductions of existing works will not be accepted.
7. Each print must be clearly labelled on the **BACK** with the entrants Name, Contact, Class No, Section & Title as show below:

Class No: 1 Section: Open (Black & White or Colour)

8. All photos must be flush mounted (photo glued onto a backing board / thick card with the edge level with the edge of the backing).
9. A maximum of **four (4) prints** per entrant may be submitted in each class. Entries that exceed this amount will be ineligible for judging at the Chief Steward's discretion. No refunds will be issued to any exhibitor.
10. Entries to be delivered to the Administration Office, Townsville Showgrounds, or posted to PO Box 5064 MC, Townsville 4810. Return postage must be included with entry fee for return of exhibits.
11. The Judge's decision will be final, and no correspondence shall be entered into.
12. Prints can be collected from the Administration Office, Townsville Showgrounds on between **Monday, 10th July 2023 & Friday, 21st July 2023** between **9am – 4pm**. All mail entries will be returned immediately after the exhibition if return postage was included with the entry form.
13. "FOR SALE" Cards or Notices are not allowed on exhibits. No exhibit will be offered "FOR SALE" without the approval of the Manager.
14. Allow space on the back of the photos for Velcro for display purposes.
15. **NO FREE PASSES WILL BE ISSUED TO EXHIBITORS.**
16. Prize money can paid to the Winners via Direct Deposit to their nominated bank account otherwise prize money/vouchers/trophies will be available for collection during office hours (**9am – 4pm**) from the Administration Office from **Monday 10th July to Friday 21st July 2023**. If exhibitors are unable to collect their prize money on the nominated days, arrangement can be made to have prize money directly

deposited into their nominated bank account or have a cheque forwarded to their address. **Any prize money not collected by Friday, 21st July 2023 will be forfeited.**

17. Each class will be awarded a first, second and third prize. The prize money will be identical for all sections being First \$70.00, Second \$50.00 & Third \$30.00 with an encouragement award, Highly Commended. An overall Grand Champion will also be awarded with \$200.00 cash.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- NOTE: The exhibits in the Photography section will be displayed for the duration of the show. It is important that all photos are well secured to their backing material as the dry air in the halls can cause the photos to come unattached and fall to the floor.
- All prints in **Classes 1-10 MUST BE no smaller than 20x25cm or no larger than 25x30cm in either portrait or landscape format** and flush mounted onto board. If the print is not in this format, disqualification will occur. **Prints in Classes 11 and 12 [Students] should have a minimum size of 12x18 cm, or no larger than 15x20 cm, in portrait or landscape format.**

2022 Photography Section Class Schedule

Class 1. Open (Black & White or Colour)

Any theme open to all entrants.

ALL PRINTS in this Class MUST BE no smaller than 20x25cm or no larger than 25x30cm in either portrait or landscape format, FLUSH MOUNTED ONTO BOARD & LABELED CLEARLY AS PER CONDITIONS OF ENTRY ON BACK/REVERSE SIDE.

Class 2. Portrait (Black & White or Colour)

A human or household pet in any situation.

ALL PRINTS in this Class MUST BE no smaller than 20x25cm or no larger than 25x30cm in either portrait or landscape format, FLUSH MOUNTED ONTO BOARD & LABELED CLEARLY AS PER CONDITIONS OF ENTRY ON BACK/REVERSE SIDE.

Class 3. Animals

Animals in the wild or wild animals in any situation. – **No pets.**

ALL PRINTS in this Class MUST BE no smaller than 20x25cm or no larger than 25x30cm in either portrait or landscape format, FLUSH MOUNTED ONTO BOARD & LABELED CLEARLY AS PER CONDITIONS OF ENTRY ON BACK/REVERSE SIDE.

Class 4. Plants

Any nature scene (hills, trees, fields, rocks through any stage of the life cycle, from seed to decay) – **No animals.**

ALL PRINTS in this Class MUST BE no smaller than 20x25cm or no larger than 25x30cm in either portrait or landscape format, FLUSH MOUNTED ONTO BOARD & LABELED CLEARLY AS PER CONDITIONS OF ENTRY ON BACK/REVERSE SIDE.

Class 5. Black & White (No Colour)

Any subject open to all entrants' creative use of black & white photography.

ALL PRINTS in this Class MUST BE no smaller than 20x25cm or no larger than 25x30cm in either portrait or landscape format, FLUSH MOUNTED ONTO BOARD & LABELED CLEARLY AS PER CONDITIONS OF ENTRY ON BACK/REVERSE SIDE.

Class 6. Macro/Close-Up

Capture an image of any subject (including landscapes)

ALL PRINTS in this Class MUST BE no smaller than 20x25cm or no larger than 25x30cm in either portrait or landscape format, FLUSH MOUNTED ONTO BOARD & LABELED CLEARLY AS PER CONDITIONS OF ENTRY ON BACK/REVERSE SIDE.

Class 7. Illustrative

Any manipulated photo.

This class is designed to showcase some of the extremes of digital photography. Use whatever amount of manipulation deemed necessary to create your final image. Example: Fantasy images.

ALL PRINTS in this Class MUST BE no smaller than 20x25cm or no larger than 25x30cm in either portrait or landscape format, FLUSH MOUNTED ONTO BOARD & LABELED CLEARLY AS PER CONDITIONS OF ENTRY ON BACK/REVERSE SIDE.

Class 8. Advertising/Commercial

Create a photo appropriate for use in advertising. Aim for your work to have commercial value in that a business would use this image to promote themselves and their business.

ALL PRINTS in this Class MUST BE no smaller than 20x25cm or no larger than 25x30cm in either portrait or landscape format, FLUSH MOUNTED ONTO BOARD & LABELED CLEARLY AS PER CONDITIONS OF ENTRY ON BACK/REVERSE SIDE.

Class 9. Landscape

Any nature scene (hills, trees, fields, rocks) – **No animals.**

ALL PRINTS in this Class MUST BE no smaller than 20x25cm or no larger than 25x30cm in either portrait or landscape format, FLUSH MOUNTED ONTO BOARD & LABELED CLEARLY AS PER CONDITIONS OF ENTRY ON BACK/REVERSE SIDE.

Class 10. First time Exhibitors

Any theme or subject. Black & White or Colour.

ALL PRINTS in this Class MUST BE no smaller than 20x25cm or no larger than 25x30cm in either portrait or landscape format, FLUSH MOUNTED ONTO BOARD & LABELED CLEARLY AS PER CONDITIONS OF ENTRY ON BACK/REVERSE SIDE.

Class 11. Primary Student (Prep – Grade 6)

Open - Any theme or subject. Black & White or Colour.

Prints in this Class [Students] should have a minimum size of 12x18 cm, or no larger than 15x20 cm, in portrait or landscape format.

Class 12. Secondary Student (Grades 7 – 12)

Open - Any theme or subject. Black & White or Colour.

Prints in this Class [Students] should have a minimum size of 12x18 cm, or no larger than 15x20 cm, in portrait or landscape format.
