DELIVERY OF ARTWORKS:

Artworks are to be delivered to the Townsville Showgrounds Office on **Monday 16th June 2025 between 8:00am – 4:00pm.**

HANGING OF ARTWORK FOR JUDGING & EXHIBITION:

Artwork will be sorted & hung from **Monday 16th of June from 9:00am** (unless advised otherwise by the TPAIA).

If you are available to assist the Fine Arts Section by volunteering some of your time to assist with the hanging of artwork, please complete the volunteer form & submit it with your nomination form by the 4th June 2025 or email Chief Steward Jessica on – jessicametz33@hotmail.com.

JUDGING:

Judging will be conducted **between the 18th - 27th June 2025.**

PRESENTATION:

Awards will be displayed for the duration of the 2025 Townsville Show Event on the artwork.

EXHIBITION:

Exhibition of Artwork will run for the duration of the 2025 Townsville Show **from Friday 4th July 2025 – Monday 7th July 2025** within the Exhibition Space beneath the Main Grandstand.

COLLECTION OF ARTWORKS:

Artworks are to be collected from the Exhibition Space beneath the Main Grandstand at the Townsville Showgrounds on **Tuesday, 8th July 2025, 10:00am – 4:00pm.**

PRIZE MONEY:

Prize Money will be deposited into the Entrants Nominated Bank Account via Direct Deposit from **Monday 14th July 2025 – Friday, 25th July 2025 between 9:00am – 4:00pm.** Alternatively Prize Money can be collected from the Townsville Show Office during the same period. If you are unable to collect your prize money & do not wish to have the money deposited into your bank account, a Cheque can be forwarded to your postal address, however you will need to contact us directly to make these arrangements. **Any Prize money not collected by 4:00pm on the 26/07/2025 will be forfeited.**

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. ALL ARTWORK ENTERED MUST BE THE ORIGINAL WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR IN CONCEPT, EXECUTION AND PROJECTION — COPIES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.
2. Work that has been entered in previous years is not acceptable. All entries must comply with law in respect to intellectual property and copyright. Work must have been completed in the last 2 years (Between June 2023 & May 2025).
3. **A maximum of three (3) entries per class by each Entrant is permissible.**
4. If an artwork does not meet criteria, it will not be judged.
5. **Maximum artwork size for each class is specified at the top of each class schedule. Please ensure you note your maximum size & ensure your artwork does not exceed the maximum size outline for your class before submitting your entry.**
6. All artwork must be delivered **READY TO HANG**. Artwork that is not presented in this manner will not be displayed or judged. Artworks on canvas **must be** mounted & ready to hang (mounting hardware or fixed bracket is required). Artworks on paper **must be** framed or laminated ready to hang. The Fine Arts Section will only provide wire hooks & clothes pegs to hang artwork, they **will not provide** any hardware such as wire or D rings etc to be fitted to canvases or frames.
7. Works of art entered in this exhibition shall not have been awarded a prize in any previous competition. The Chief Stewards have the final decision on works entered and reserves the right to reject any entry without explanation. THE JUDGES DECISION WILL BE FINAL AND BINDING AND NO CORRESPONDENCE WILL BE ENTERED INTO.
8. **Loss and Damages:** All expenses in connection with forwarding, packaging, returning and insurance of entries shall be borne by the competitors. The TPAIA will take all reasonable care, but NO responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage that occurs. While all care will be taken with exhibits during the course of the exhibition, the TPA&IA will take **NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE ITEMS AS THEY ARE EXHIBITED AT THE OWNER'S RISK.**
9. **Exhibition Space:** Townsville Show Fine Arts Committee will endeavour to hang all entries submitted. This will depend on the available hanging space and number of entries. The Committee regrets that it is unable to guarantee that all works will be hung but can guarantee that all entries will be judged.
10. The Chief Steward may transfer entries entered into the wrong class to an appropriate class at the Chief Steward's own discretion.

11. In the event that any class has three or less entries, the Chief Steward will withhold all of the prize money or may amalgamate the class with another class at their discretion.
12. The TPA&IA reserve the right to appoint another judge should the circumstances change.
13. **The Champion Sash Awards** are judged from the first prizes in nominated classes.
14. **Ensure your artwork is labelled correctly** on the back of each entry (or on base if it is a sculpture) as follows:

15. **Prize money/vouchers/trophies** will be available for collection from the Townsville Show Office from **Tuesday 8th July 2025 – Friday, 26th July 2025 between 9:00am – 4:00pm**. If exhibitors are unable to collect their prize money on the nominated days, arrangement can be made to have prize money directly deposited into their nominated bank account or have a cheque forwarded to their address. **Any prize or prize money not collected by Friday 26th July 2025 will be forfeited.**
Prize money stated in the schedule excludes GST. GST will be added to the prize money for exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes and provide our Association with a Recipient Created Tax Invoice. Townsville Pastoral Agricultural & Industrial Association will not issue tax invoices in respect of prizes. Some prizes may be in the form of vouchers or prizes from Sponsors (cash will not be given out instead of prizes). Please inform the Townsville Pastoral Agricultural & Industrial Association that you are registered when nominating and notify TPA&IA again, if you cease to be registered.
16. **Sale of Artwork** - Artists may provide a card with selling price and contact details to be attached to the bottom right corner of the artwork during the exhibition. These **MUST NOT** be attached prior to judging (Stewards will attach for artists). CHIEF STEWARD or VOLUNTEERS will be available to organise the sale of artwork during the show times unless artists advise otherwise, however you Must specify/write "Steward Sale Approved" if you wish to have the Section Steward assist/coordinate the sale of your item for your specified price. The Sale price should also be clearly written on the label on the reverse side of the piece as specified in Condition No. 14 above. **Chief Steward will contact artists if artwork is sold during show times and money can be collected from the Show Office after the show.**
17. **Admin & Entry Fees.** Entrants required to pay one \$2.00 Admin fee for their nomination, plus any Entry Fees for any of their artworks submitted as outlined on the Entry Form. The T.P.A & I.A. are required to pay GST on all entry/admin fees received. ALL entry/admin fees stated in the schedules include GST. ALL exhibitors

must pay the GST inclusive entry/admin fees whether they are registered for GST purposes or not registered. Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes may be able to claim a credit for GST paid. We recommend you check with your Financial Adviser or the Australian Taxation Office. To assist with any claim for credit we will forward all exhibitors a **Tax Invoice/Receipt** for the total entry/admin fees received including GST.

If a primary or secondary student/child wishes to enter into Section 5 Fine Arts section (rather than Section 6 Junior & Disability Fine Arts), then they are expected to pay all entry fees as per a normal exhibitor.

- 18. Entry Forms MUST be completed correctly IN FULL using PRINTING ONLY** in black or blue pen only to ensure that stewards are able to read details correctly & easily. Admin Staff & Stewards WILL NOT complete any part of an Entry Form for an Entrant. Please take the time to ensure your Entry Form is completed correctly before submitting as failure to do so may result in your entry being done so incorrectly. The TPAIA & their Stewards take no responsibility for incomplete or incorrectly completed Entry Forms.

The TPAIA will NOT supply any materials or assist with attaching any Wires/Strings/D rings/Hooks etc.
These must be attached to the artwork by the entrant prior to delivery to the TPAIA.

Class 1: Open Category – Any Theme

Any theme, any medium on canvas or paper.

Maximum size for artwork in this category is 100cm x 100cm including frame.

ENTRY: \$20 PRIZE MONEY: 1st \$150 2nd \$100 3rd \$50

Class 2: Drawing – Any Theme

Charcoal, ink, pencil on canvas or paper.

Maximum size for artwork in this category is 100cm x 100cm including frame.

ENTRY: \$20 PRIZE MONEY: 1st \$150 2nd \$100 3rd \$50

Class 3: Special Theme for 2025 – Agriculture/Outback Australia

(e.g. Livestock, country landscapes, etc).

Any medium on canvas or paper.

Maximum size for artwork in this category is 100cm x 100cm including frame.

ENTRY: \$20 PRIZE MONEY: 1st \$150 2nd \$100 3rd \$50

Class 4: Still Life – Any theme

Any medium, using special items or textiles. E.g. Clay, Cardboard, Paper Mache etc

Maximum Size for artwork in this category is H60cm x W60cm x D60cm including frame.
