



NOTE:

- IF CAMPING ***IS NOT*** PRE-BOOKED YOU ***WILL NOT BE PERMITTED*** TO ENTER YOUR VEHICLE TO THE GROUNDS.
- IF YOU HAVE NOT ARRANGED CAMPING, YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO STAY WITH YOUR CATTLE IN THE SHOWGROUNDS.

ENTRY FEES:

- The TPA & IA is required to pay GST on all entry fees received
- All entry fees stated in the schedule include GST
- All exhibitors must pay the GST inclusive entry fees whether they are registered for GST purposes or not registered
- Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes may be able to claim a credit for GST paid. We recommend you check with your Financial Advisor or the Australian Taxation Office. To assist with any claim for credit we will forward to exhibitors on request a Tax Invoice/Receipt for the total entry fees received including GST.

SPONSORSHIP:

- The Association is required to pay GST on sponsorship monies received.
- Sponsorship monies stated in schedule includes GST paid.
- Sponsors who are registered for GST purposes may be able to claim a credit for GST paid. We recommend sponsors check with their Financial Advisor or the Australian Taxation Office. We will issue a Tax Invoice to all sponsors.

PRIZE MONEY:

- Prize money stated in the schedule excludes GST. GST will be added to the prize money for exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes and provide our association with a Tax Invoice. Some prizes from sponsors may be vouchers or 'prizes' – cash will not be given out in exchange.
- Prize money will be available for collection from the Administration Office from **Monday 07th July 2025 – Friday 11th July 2025 9:00 – 3:00pm**. If exhibitors are unable to collect their prize money on the nominated day, arrangements can be made to have the prize money directly deposited into their nominated bank account or have a cheque forwarded to their address. Prize money not collected within this time will be forfeited to the Stud Cattle Section unless prior arrangements are made.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Please ensure a copy of Registration Certificates or Progeny Registration is accompanied with **ALL NOMINATIONS**.
- All cattle must be bonafide property of the exhibitor, registered with their respective cattle breed societies and shown in accordance with the society's regulations – copies of registration certificates must be available for inspection on request by the Show Coordinator.
- No cattle are allowed as non-competitive unless approved by the Show Coordinator – nomination plus entry fee must be paid by close of entry date.
- An animal born 1st July will be deemed to be 12 months old on the following 1st July. Date of Birth must be supplied on entry form.
- Any calf shown on a cow is not eligible to be shown in the 6 to 9 months classes. Any calf shown on a cow must be under 9 months of age – calf details must be given on entry form on the line directly below the dam.
- The Show Coordinator reserves the right to combine any breed/sections where numbers are insufficient. To insert, combine or delete any class or classes within said sections where numbers of competing animals warrant such action and to change nominations misclassified.
- Substitutions are only accepted within the original nominated class.

Exhibitor Passes will be issued based on animal stud class entries as per the following: 1 to 3 beasts – 1 pass; 4 to 6 beasts – 2 passes; 7 to 9 beasts – 3 passes; 10 and over – 4 passes.

Safety - Cattle and Public: All Males 9 months and under 24 months must be nose ringed or dogged with lead attached when being moved. All Males over 24 months must be nose ringed with lead attached when being moved. All Females or Steers 12 months and over must be nose ringed or dogged with lead attached when being shown. All cattle must have a halter

with lead securely attached when animals are being moved and must be in the handler's control at all times. Neck straps and/or chains MUST be used in the stalls.

Delivery of cattle (by 4pm Friday 4th July 2025) is via the Parkes Street bottom gate see map for ease of access. Vehicles must be removed from the grounds once cattle are unloaded unless pre-booked camping has been approved. If camping – vehicles may not leave the Showgrounds before 12am Tuesday 08th July 2025 as no “vehicle passes” can be issued for before this time. If you want to leave during show hours you will need to park on the street outside of the grounds. All Stud cattle must be on the grounds by 4pm Friday 4th July 2025 and may not leave the Showgrounds before 12am Tuesday 08th July 2025 – please contact the Steward if there are extenuating circumstances.

N.L.I.S. MOVEMENT TO/FROM SHOW: All cattle MUST have a NLIS tags in place. Cattle will be scanned on site by the steward and processed through the show society. Exhibitors can also supply the details of each animal's visual tag number on the entry form. Waybills must be up to date (with property of origin's PIC) and must be supplied to the Steward on arrival at the grounds. Cattle will be sighted onto the grounds. Townsville Showgrounds PIC = QGTV0034 for use on the Waybil. A Cattle Health Declaration must also be supplied.

STALL ALLOCATIONS. Stall space will be reserved for the number of beasts entered as entries are received. Stall numbers will be advised as exhibitors arrive on Friday. Bedding is supplied in the stalls - exhibitors must keep the stalls and isle clear of all rubbish and animal waste.


CATTLE. There are a limited number of pens available in the cattle yard for use by exhibitors prior to show day. Exhibitors who wish to have use of these pens must contact the Steward by Friday 27th June 2025. All Cattle must arrive onto the Show Grounds before 4pm Friday 4th July 2025 and remain until 12am Tuesday 08th July 2025 after the closing of the show. Any wishes to leave prior must be discussed with the office and steward and are not guaranteed.

CAMPING: Is not permitted in the Stud Cattle Sheds or in the vicinity of the Stud Cattle sheds or the Judging Ring. Space is available for camping in the designated areas of the Showgrounds – please see campsite application or contact the show office for details.

All animals needing to be weighed or measured will be processed when informed by steward. 'Milk tooth' cattle will be mouthed at this time.

JUDGING: Sunday 6th July 2025 Cattle Judging will commence at approximately 09:00 am (start time can be changed at the discretion of the Steward) in the judging ring outside the Stud Cattle pavilion. All cattle must be tractable and led into the ring for judging. All Exhibitors/handlers must comply with all stewards' instructions. The Judge's decision is final - no correspondence will be entered into.
