HANGING OF ARTWORK FOR JUDGING & EXHIBITION:

Artwork will be sorted & hung on Saturday 7th June from 9:00am

If you are available to assist the Fine Arts Section by volunteering some of your time to assist with the hanging of artwork, please advise the Townsville Show Office.

JUDGING:

Judging will be conducted prior to the opening of the 2025 Townsville Show.

PRESENTATION:

Awards will be displayed along with artworks for the duration of the 2025 Townsville Show Event.

EXHIBITION:

Exhibition of Artwork will run for the duration of the 2025 Townsville Show from Friday 4th July – Monday 7th July 2025 within the Exhibition Space beneath the Main Grandstand.

COLLECTION OF ARTWORKS:

Tuesday 8th July 2025, 9:00am – 4:30pm

Artworks are to be collected from the Exhibition Space beneath the Main Grandstand at the Townsville Showgrounds.

PRIZE MONEY:

Prize Money will be deposited into the entrants nominated bank account via direct Deposit from **Monday 14th July 2025 – Friday 25th July 2025 between 9:00am – 4:00pm.** Alternatively prize money can be collected from the Townsville Show Office during the same period. If you are unable to collect your prize money and do not wish to have the money deposited into your bank account, a cheque can be forwarded to your postal address, however you will need to contact us directly to make these arrangements.
Any Prize money not collected by 4:00pm on Friday 25/07/2025 will be forfeited.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All artwork entered must be the original work of the exhibitor in concept, execution and projection — copies are not acceptable.
2. **Only paintings/drawings will be accepted in the sections for individual artists. Group murals may include collage elements.**
3. Murals submitted are to be a group effort with 6 or more artists contributing to the final piece. A 6x4 photograph of the contributing artists with their artwork must be submitted with the entry.
4. Work that has been entered in previous years is not acceptable. All entries must comply with law in respect to intellectual property and copyright. Work must have been completed in the last year (between June 2024 & May 2025).
5. A maximum of three (3) entries per class by each entrant is permissible.
6. Maximum artwork size for each class is specified at the top of each class schedule.
7. If an artwork does not meet criteria or is not labelled, it will not be judged.
8. Ensure your artwork is labelled on the back of each entry as follows:

9. All artwork must be delivered **READY TO HANG**. Artwork that is not presented in this manner will not be displayed or judged. Artworks on canvas **must be** mounted & ready to hang (mounting hardware or fixed bracket is required). Artworks on paper **must be** framed or laminated ready to hang. The Fire Arts Section will only provide wire hooks & clothes pegs to hang artwork, they **will not provide** any hardware such as wire or D rings etc to be fitted to canvases or frames.

10. Works of art entered in this exhibition shall not have been awarded a prize in any previous competition. The Chief Stewards have the final decision on works entered and reserves the right to reject any entry without explanation. The judges decision will be final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. Loss and Damages: All expenses in connection with forwarding, packaging, returning and insurance of entries shall be borne by the competitors. The TPAIA will take all reasonable care, but NO responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage that occurs.
12. Exhibition Space: Townsville Show Fine Arts Committee will endeavour to hang all entries submitted. This will depend on the available hanging space and number of entries. The Committee regrets that it is unable to guarantee that all works will be hung but can guarantee that all entries will be judged.
13. The Chief Steward may transfer entries entered into the wrong class to an appropriate class at the Chief Steward's own discretion.
14. In the event that any class has three or less entries, the Chief Steward will withhold all of the prize money or may amalgamate the class with another class at their discretion.
15. The TPA&IA reserve the right to appoint another judge should the circumstances change.
16. Prize money stated in the schedule excludes GST. GST will be added to the prize money for exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes and provide our association with a recipient created tax invoice. TPA&IA will not issue tax invoices in respect of prizes. Some prizes may be in the form of vouchers or prizes from Sponsors (cash will not be given out instead of prizes). Please inform the TPA&IA that you are registered when nominating and notify TPA&IA again, if you cease to be registered.
18. Sale of Artwork - Artists may provide a card with selling price and contact details to be attached to the bottom right corner of the artwork during the exhibition. These MUST NOT be attached prior to judging. The TPA&IA will not act as an agent for art sales. It is up to the customer to contact the artist directly. The sale price should also be clearly written on the label on the reverse side of the piece as specified in condition no. 6 above.
19. Artists with a disability section entries are open to all individuals with disabilities/impairments. Assisted means the artist was assisted by another individual to complete their submitted artwork. Unassisted means the artist completed the submitted artwork without assistance from any other individual.

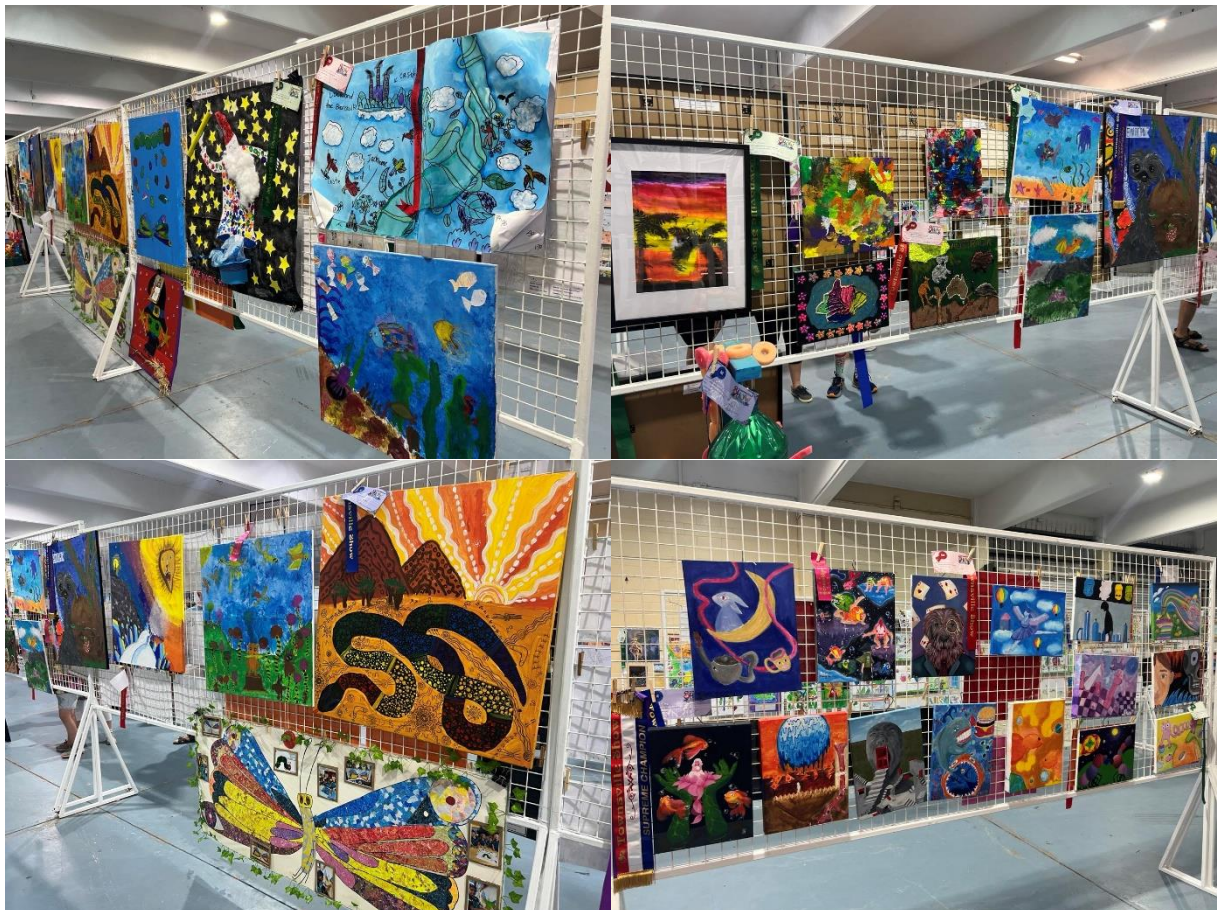
Thank you to all those who have dedicated their time and efforts in making the Townsville Schools Fine Arts section a success in the 2025 Townsville Show.

Any medium on paper or canvas (no larger than 76.2cm x 76.2cm including frame, no templates or collage elements)

Class No. 2: Famous Landmarks

Any medium on paper or canvas (no larger than 76.2cm x 76.2cm including frame, no templates or collage elements)

Section: SECONDARY – GRADE 7, 8 & 9

PRIZE MONEY: 1st - \$75 2nd - \$50 3rd - \$25

Class No. 3: Open – Any theme

Any medium on paper or canvas (no larger than 76.2cm x 76.2cm including frame, no templates or collage elements)

Class No. 4: Emotional Expression

Any medium on paper or canvas (no larger than 76.2cm x 76.2cm including frame, no templates or collage elements)

Section: PRIMARY – GRADE 4, 5 & 6

PRIZE MONEY: 1st - \$25 2nd - \$15 3rd - \$10

Class No. 5: Summer Days

Any medium on paper or canvas (no larger than A3, no templates or collage elements)

Section: PRIMARY – GRADE 2 & 3

Any medium on paper or canvas (no larger than A3, no templates or collage elements)

FINE ARTS - MURALS

Entries Close: Friday 30th May 2025 at 4:00pm.

All Murals to be completed as a class/group of school aged children

Murals are to be no larger than 1sqm (100cm x 100cm)

A 6x4 photo of the artists/group with their work MUST be submitted with the artwork.

Classes/Groups are invited to create a mural using the theme. 3 or more artists must contribute to the single piece of artwork. The Contributing Artists Names, School or Group (if applicable, e.g Weir State School or PCYC Oonoonba OSHC), a single contact name & contact phone number must also be printed on the bottom left corner on the back of the artwork as outlined in the “Conditions of Entry”. If a mural is submitted & is not in ready to hang condition, the Mural will not be judged or displayed at the Townsville Show.

Mural Definition:

A very large image, such as a painting or enlarged photograph. Normally applied directly to a wall or ceiling, now generally completed on a large flat surface & attached to the desired area.

Mural entries **MUST** be mounted using one of the following options & be ready to hang:

- a) Cardboard with ties on all four corners to facilitate hanging.
- b) Calico with ties on all four corners to facilitate hanging.
- c) Canvas with suitable wire or brackets to facilitate hanging.
