

TOWNSVILLE SHOWGROUNDS NIGHT MARKETS

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR STALLHOLDER

1. APPLICATIONS & BOOKINGS

- 1.1 Submission of a Stallholder Application does not guarantee acceptance into the event.
- 1.2 The Townsville Showgrounds reserves the right to approve or decline any application at its sole discretion.
- 1.3 Site allocations are determined by the Event Organisers and may vary from month to month.
- 1.4 Stallholders must only sell the products listed on their approved application.

2. PAYMENTS & CANCELLATIONS

- 2.1 Payment is required within the timeframe advised upon approval of your application.
- 2.2 Sites are not confirmed until full payment has been received.
- 2.3 Site fees are non-refundable unless the event is cancelled by the Townsville Showgrounds.
- 2.4 The Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel unpaid bookings and reallocate the site.

3. TRADING HOURS

- 3.1 Trading hours will be advised prior to each Night Market.
- 3.2 Stallholders are required to trade for the full duration of the event.
- 3.3 Early pack-down or departure is not permitted without prior approval from the Event Organisers.

4. SET-UP & PACK-DOWN

- 4.1 Set-up and pack-down times will be provided before each event.
- 4.2 All sites must be fully operational before the commencement of trading.
- 4.3 Sites must be completely cleared after the event within the times advised by the Event Organisers.

5. VEHICLES

- 5.1 Vehicles must be removed from the event area before trading commences unless authorised by the Event Organisers.
- 5.2 No vehicle movements are permitted during trading hours without approval.



6. SITE REQUIREMENTS

- 6.1 Stallholders are responsible for supplying all equipment required for their site, including marquees, tables, chairs, lighting and extension leads.
- 6.2 Marquees must be adequately weighted at all times.
- 6.3 Pegs may only be used where approved by the Event Organisers.
- 6.4 Stallholders must keep their display within the boundaries of their allocated site.

7. ELECTRICITY

- 7.1 All electrical equipment must be tested and tagged in accordance with Queensland regulations.
- 7.2 The Event Organisers reserve the right to disconnect unsafe electrical equipment.
- 7.3 Food Stalls and Food Trucks receive one 10A power outlet where included in their booking.
- 7.4 Additional power requirements must be requested prior to the event.

8. FOOD VENDORS

- 8.1 Food vendors must comply with all Queensland Health and Food Safety legislation.
- 8.2 Food vendors are responsible for obtaining all licences, permits and approvals required to operate.
- 8.3 Food vendors using gas appliances must carry an appropriate fire extinguisher.

9. STALLHOLDER CONDUCT

- 9.1 Stallholders and their staff must behave in a professional and respectful manner at all times.
- 9.2 The Event Organisers reserve the right to remove any stallholder displaying unacceptable behaviour.
- 9.3 Stallholders must comply with all directions issued by Event Staff, Security and Emergency Services.

10. ALCOHOL

- 10.1 The Townsville Showgrounds holds the Liquor Licence for the event.
- 10.2 The sale of alcoholic beverages by stallholders is strictly prohibited unless authorised by the Townsville Showgrounds.
- 10.3 Consumption of alcohol by stallholders during trading hours is not permitted.

11. SITE PRESENTATION

- 11.1 Stallholders are responsible for keeping their site clean and presentable throughout the event.
- 11.2 All rubbish must be removed from the site at the conclusion of the event.
- 11.3 Failure to leave the site clean may affect future applications.

12. ADVERTISING & SALES

- 12.1 Stallholders may only advertise and sell products approved as part of their application.
- 12.2 Selling, canvassing or distributing promotional material outside the allocated site is not permitted.



13. LIABILITY

13.1 Stallholders participate at their own risk.

13.2 The Townsville Showgrounds accepts no responsibility for loss, theft or damage to any property.

13.3 Stallholders are responsible for the security of their own equipment and stock.

14. GENERAL CONDITIONS

14.1 The Event Organisers reserve the right to amend these Terms & Conditions at any time.

14.2 Failure to comply with these Terms & Conditions may result in removal from the event and refusal of future applications.

14.3 The Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, postpone or alter the event due to weather, safety concerns or circumstances beyond their control.

EVENT CANCELLATION

The Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event due to severe weather or circumstances beyond their control.
