- **Delivering the Townsville-to-Mount** Isa CopperString project to bring high-voltage electricity infrastructure and generate more jobs for locals.




Hello everyone! We invite you to visit the Hobby Ceramics display at the 2025 Townsville Show, located under the Main Grandstand

CHOP TO IT!

It's said that woodchopping was born from one man's desire to outdo his mates. What began as a test of strength and skill between two timbermen has become a global sport, believed to be one of the very few that evolved directly from daily work. The first official competition took place in the backyard of a local hotel in Ulverstone. Tasmania, in 1870. Two locals challenged each other to see who could fell a tree the fastest. That friendly wager marked the beginning of one of the world's oldest competitive sports, and it has grown in popularity ever

In 2025, the Townsville Show Association is proud to once again present a full three-day woodchop program featuring a wide range of events: sawing, parent/child relays, chainsaw vs axe races, combination relays, handicaps and

championships. Competitors will travel from as far south as Tasmania and across the Eastern States to take part, enjoying our warmer winter and the well-known hospitality of North Queensland.

Woodchopping is a true family sport, with competitors ranging from juniors to veterans in their 80s. The field continues to grow in both strength and the number of female competitors, including our very own Takiah Moore-Barret, who was recently crowned Women's World Champion in the 275mm Underhand event at the Royal Easter Show in Sydney. HOW MATTHEW RICHARDSON TURNED HIS BACK ON TOWNSVILLE'S MOST ICONIC COMMUNITY EVENT

When the Townsville Show, a beloved not-for-profit institution with over a century of history, requested a simple gesture of support from the Townsville City Council, the response from Matthew Richardson, Director of Infrastructure and Operations, was anything but community-minded.

Let's be clear. The request wasn't for trucks, staff, or special services. It was simply to waive dump fees, a modest ask that had been granted in previous years. The Show, run entirely by volunteers, had already committed to handling all waste transport. All they needed was a small gesture of goodwill: to be able to dispose of rubbish without being penalised for serving the very city Mr. Richardson claims to "grow."

Instead, the Show's team received a cold, bureaucratic refusal. In a series of delayed, dismissive responses, Richardson repeatedly cited "financial sustainability" and "fairness" as excuses. He failed to distinguish between grassroots community efforts and commercial operations. He even had the audacity to suggest that forcing a volunteer-run event to absorb dump fees somehow delivers "value to the ratepayer."

This is not just tone-deaf leadership, it's a failure of civic responsibility.

Worse still, repeated attempts by the Show's organisers to contact Mr. Richardson were ignored. Voicemails went unanswered. Emails sat idle.

Only after persistent follow-ups did a response finally arrive, void of empathy and full of corporate jargon.

Matthew Richardson, whose public record includes controversial projects like the scrapped Strand parking meters and representing Council during a Senate inquiry into disaster resilience, has once again demonstrated a lack of connection to the community. The same man who temporarily stepped into the CEO role during a hush-hush HR meeting in 2024 now can't pick up the phone or back a local institution like the Townsville Show.

This is not a question of resources. It's a question of priorities.

Under Richardson's operational leadership, Townsville City Council paid \$2.6 million in termination benefits in a single financial year. \$350,000 of that exceeded contractual limits. And yet now, we're told that waiving dump fees for a not-forprofit event is financially unsustainable?

Let's call this what it is. Institutional apathy disguised as fiscal responsibility.

Mr. Richardson does not want to help the Townsville Show. That much is painfully clear. And in doing so, he has sent a loud message to the community:

You're on your own.


