Friday, 27TH May 2022, 4:00pm. Nomination forms MUST be submitted & Entry Fees & Admin Fees MUST be paid. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**

DELIVERY OF ARTWORKS:

Artworks are to be delivered to the Exhibition Space beneath the Main Grandstand at the Townsville Showgrounds on **Friday, 3rd June 2022 between 9:00am – 4:30pm.**

HANGING OF ARTWORK FOR JUDGING & EXHIBITION:

Artwork will be sorted & hung on **Saturday 4th June from 9:00am** (unless advised otherwise by the TPAIA).

If you are available to assist the Fine Arts Section by volunteering some of your time to assist with the hanging of artwork, please advise the Townsville Show Office prior to the 27th May 2022.

JUDGING:

Judging will be conducted **Monday 6th June 2022** (unless otherwise stated by the TPAIA).

PRESENTATION:

Due to ongoing Covid impacts, there will not be an official Awards Presentation Event, rather awards will be displayed for the duration of the 2022 Townsville Show Event.

EXHIBITION:

Exhibition of Artwork will run for the duration of the 2022 Townsville Show **from Friday 1st July 2022 – Monday 4th July 2022** within the Exhibition Space beneath the Main Grandstand.

COLLECTION OF ARTWORKS:

Artworks are to be collected from the Exhibition Space beneath the Main Grandstand at the Townsville Showgrounds on **Tuesday, 5th July 2022, 9:00am – 4:30pm.**

PRIZE MONEY:

Prize Money will be deposited into the Entrants Nominated Bank Account via Direct Deposit from **Monday 11th July 2022 – Friday, 22nd July 2022 between 9:00am – 4:00pm.** Alternatively Prize Money can be collected from the Townsville Show Office during the same period.

If you are unable to collect your prize money & do not wish to have the money deposited into your bank account, a Cheque can be forwarded to your postal address, however you will need to contact us directly to make these arrangements.

Any Prize money not collected by 4:00pm on the 22/07/2022 will be forfeited.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. ALL ARTWORK ENTERED MUST BE THE ORIGINAL WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR IN CONCEPT, EXECUTION AND PROJECTION — COPIES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.
2. Work that has been entered in previous years is not acceptable. All entries must comply with law in respect to intellectual property and copyright. Work must have been completed in the last year (Between June 2021 & May 2022).
3. **A maximum of two entries per class by each Entrant is permissible.**
4. If an artwork does not meet criteria, it will not be judged.
5. **Maximum artwork size for each class is specified at the top of each class schedule. Please ensure you note your maximum size & ensure your artwork does not exceed the maximum size outline for your class before submitting your entry.**
6. All artwork must be delivered **READY TO HANG**. Artwork that is not presented in this manner will not be displayed or judged. **Artworks on canvas must be mounted & ready to hang (mounting hardware or fixed bracket is required). Artworks on paper must be framed or laminated ready to hang.** The Fire Arts Section will only provide wire hooks & clothes pegs to hang artwork, they **will not provide** any hardware such as wire or D rings etc to be fitted to canvases or frames.
7. Works of art entered in this exhibition shall not have been awarded a prize in any previous competition. The Chief Stewards have the final decision on works entered and reserves the right to reject any entry without explanation. THE JUDGES DECISION WILL BE FINAL AND BINDING AND NO CORRESPONDENCE WILL BE ENTERED INTO.
8. **ONLY paintings / drawings will be accepted in this section.** If you wish to attach objects to your painting/drawing (e.g. ribbons, bows, diamantes etc.), your work belongs in the Arts & Crafts section & will not be accepted/judged in this section.
9. Loss and Damages: All expenses in connection with forwarding, packaging, returning and insurance of entries shall be borne by the competitors. The TPAIA will take all reasonable care, but NO responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage that occurs. While all care will be taken with exhibits during the course of the exhibition, the TPA&IA will take **NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE ITEMS AS THEY ARE EXHIBITED AT THE OWNER'S RISK.**
10. Exhibition Space: Townsville Show Fine Arts Committee will endeavour to hang all entries submitted. This will depend on the available hanging space and number of entries. The Committee regrets that it is unable to guarantee that all works will be hung but can guarantee that all entries will be judged.

11. The Chief Steward may transfer entries entered into the wrong class to an appropriate class at the Chief Steward's own discretion.
12. Should the judge consider the exhibits are not up to exhibition standard in the adult sections, these works will not be judged.
13. In the event that any class has three or less entries, the Chief Steward will withhold all of the prize money or may amalgamate the class with another class at their discretion.
14. The TPA&IA reserve the right to appoint another judge should the circumstances change.
15. The Champion Sash Awards are judged from the first prizes in nominated classes.
16. Ensure your artwork is labelled correctly on the back of each entry as follows:

15. Prize money/vouchers/trophies will be available for collection from the Townsville Show Office from **Monday 11th July 2022 until Friday 22nd July 2020 between 9.00am – 4.00pm**. If exhibitors are unable to collect their prize money on the nominated days, arrangement can be made to have prize money directly deposited into their nominated bank account or have a cheque forwarded to their address. A form for your preferred payment option will be available from the Administration Office. **Any prize money not collected by Friday 22nd July 2022 will be forfeited.**

Prize money stated in the schedule excludes GST. GST will be added to the prize money for exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes and provide our Association with a Recipient Created Tax Invoice. Townsville Pastoral Agricultural & Industrial Association will not issue tax invoices in respect of prizes. Some prizes may be in the form of vouchers or prizes from Sponsors (cash will not be given out instead of prizes). Please inform the Townsville Pastoral Agricultural & Industrial

Association that you are registered when nominating and notify TPA&IA again, if you cease to be registered.

16. Sale of Artwork - Artists may provide a card with selling price and contact details to be attached to the bottom right corner of the artwork during the exhibition. These **MUST NOT** be attached prior to judging. THE TPA&IA **WILL NOT** ACT AS AN AGENT FOR ART SALES. IT IS UP TO THE CUSTOMER TO CONTACT THE ARTIST DIRECTLY. The Sale price should also be clearly written on the label on the reverse side of the piece as specified in Condition No. 14 above.
17. Disabled Artists Section entries are open to all individuals with disabilities/impairments. Assisted means the Artist/Entrant was assisted by another individual to complete their submitted artwork. Unassisted means the Artist/Entrant completed the submitted artwork without assistance from any other individual.
18. Murals Section is open to junior artists only aged between 5 years & 15 years of age (or year 10 students who are 16yrs of age). Murals submitted are to be a group effort with 6 or more artists contributing to the final piece. A 6x4 photograph of the contributing artists with their artwork must be submitted with the entry.
19. Admin & Entry Fees. Individual Junior Entrants are only required to pay one \$2.00 Admin fee for their nomination, they are not required to pay Entry Fees for any of their artworks submitted. Adult entrants (in the Disability category) & Mural Submissions are required to pay both an Entry Fee of \$5.00 for each artwork submitted & one \$2.00 Admin Fee as outlined on the Entry Form. The T.P.A & I.A. are required to pay GST on all entry/admin fees received. ALL entry/admin fees stated in the schedules include GST. ALL exhibitors must pay the GST inclusive entry/admin fees whether they are registered for GST purposes or not registered. Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes may be able to claim a credit for GST paid. We recommend you check with your Financial Adviser or the Australian Taxation Office. To assist with any claim for credit we will forward all exhibitors a **Tax Invoice/Receipt** for the total entry/admin fees received including GST. If a primary or secondary student/child wishes to enter into the 'Artists' Fine Arts section, then they are expected to pay all entry fees as per a normal exhibitor.
20. Entry Forms **MUST** be completed correctly **IN FULL** using **PRINTING ONLY** in black or blue pen only to ensure that stewards are able to read details correctly & easily. Admin Staff & Stewards **WILL NOT** complete any part of an Entry Form for an Entrant. Please take the time to ensure your Entry Form is completed correctly before submitting as failure to do so may result in your entry being done so incorrectly. The TPAIA & their Stewards take no responsibility for incomplete or incorrectly completed Entry Forms.
