### **ENTRY FEES:**

- The TPA & IA is required to pay GST on all entry fees received. **All** entry fees stated in the schedule **includes GST**.
- **All** exhibitors must pay the GST inclusive entry fees whether they are registered for GST purposes or not.
- Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes may be able to claim a credit for GST paid. We recommend you check with your Financial Advisor or the Australian Taxation Office. To assist with any claim for credit we will forward at the exhibitors request a **Tax Invoice/Receipt** for the total entry fees received including GST.

### **SPONSORSHIP:**

- The Association is required to pay GST on sponsorship monies received.
- Sponsorship monies stated in the front of the schedule includes GST paid.
- Sponsors who are registered for GST purposes may be able to claim a credit for GST paid. We recommend sponsors check with their Financial Advisor or the Australian Taxation Office. We will issue a Tax Invoice to all sponsors.

### **PRIZE MONEY:**

- Prize money stated in the schedule excludes GST. **1. Bush House, Orchid & Bonsai** nominations close 12noon Thursday 29 June 2023.  
Entries to be benched by 8.30am Friday 30 June 2023 for judging to commence at 9.00am. No late Entries accepted.

No leaf shine to be used on Bush House plants and only 1 plant type per pot. Entries will be accepted between 1.00pm and 7.00pm Thursday 29 June and up to 8.30am Friday 30 June. *Presentation of plants is important.*

**2. Cut Flowers, Floral Art & Juniors** to be nominated by Friday 12noon 30 June 2023.  
To be benched by 8.30am on Saturday 1 July 2023 for judging at 9.00am. Late Entries, which must be completed on the correct Entry Form, will be permitted only for Cut Flowers if another entry has already been made, prior to the nomination close date and must be submitted by 8.30am Saturday 1 July 2023. Please have these in writing for the stewards. **Exhibitors to supply their own containers.** Cut means more than 1 flower. Stem means 1 flower.

**3.** Entry for exhibitors to the Showgrounds to deliver their pieces for judging will only be permitted through the Besser/Hanson Gate (behind the main grandstand located approx. halfway along the Townsville showgrounds on the Ingham Service Rd) between 6.30am and 8.30am on Friday and Saturday as above.

**CARS ARE ONLY ALLOWED ON THE TOWNSVILLE SHOWGROUNDS ON FRIDAY THE 30<sup>th</sup> June 2023 FROM 7.00AM TO 3.00PM AND SATURDAY 1<sup>st</sup> JULY 2023 FROM 6.30AM TO 8.30AM.**

4. All floriculture exhibits to remain on display for the duration of the 2023 Townsville Show. Exhibits can be taken from the grounds via the Hanson/Besser Gate on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2023 from 8.00am until 2.00pm
5. “FOR SALE” CARDS OR NOTICES are not allowed on exhibits. No exhibit will be offered “For Sale” without the approval of the Association’s Secretary.
6. Prize Money will be deposited into each winner’s nominated bank account, entrants should ensure they have provided correct bank details on their entry/nomination form upon submission. If an entrant would prefer to collect their prize money in Cash or if they are collecting vouchers or trophies, these will be available for collection from the Administration Office from Monday 10<sup>th</sup> July until Friday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2023, during the hours of 9:00am to 4:00pm. If an exhibitor is unable to collect their prize during this period, they **MUST** contact the Townsville Show office to make alternate arrangements, **failure to provide bank details/collect prize money/ make alternate arrangement with the Admin Office during the nominated period may result in prize/prize money being forfeited.**

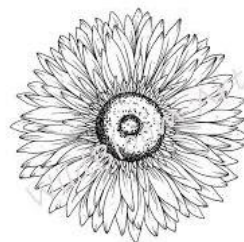

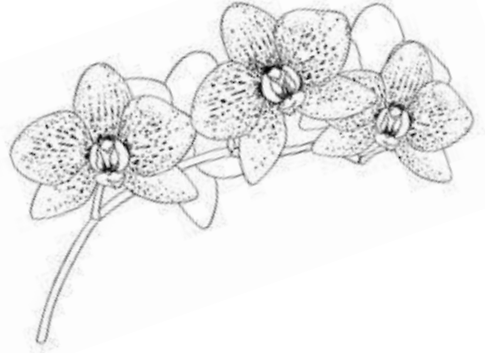
