## **ENTRY FEES:**

- The TPA & IA is required to pay GST on all entry fees received.
- All entry fees stated in this schedule include GST.
- All exhibitors must pay the GST inclusive entry fees whether they are registered for GST purposes or not.
- Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes may be able to claim a credit for GST paid. We recommend you check with your Financial Advisor or the Australian Taxation Office. To assist with any claim for credit we will forward at the exhibitors request a Tax Invoice/Receipt for the total fees received including GST.

## **SPONSORSHIP:**

- The Association is required to pay GST on sponsorship monies received.
- Sponsorship monies stated in the front of the schedule includes GST paid.
- Sponsors who are registered for GST purposes may be able to claim a credit for GST paid. We recommend sponsors check with their Financial Advisor or the Australian Taxation Office. We will issue a Tax Invoice to all sponsors.

## **PRIZE MONEY:**

- Prize money stated in the schedule excludes GST. GST will be added to the prize money for exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes and provide our Association with a Recipient Created Tax Invoice. Townsville Pastoral Agricultural & Industrial Association will not issue tax invoices in respect of prizes.
- Some prizes may be in the form of vouchers or prizes from Sponsors. Cash will not be given out instead of prizes). Please inform the Townsville Pastoral Agricultural & Industrial Association that you are registered when nominating and notify TPA & IA again, if you cease to be registered.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All persons upon entering any class in this schedule agree to indemnify the Townsville Pastoral Agricultural and Industrial Association against liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness to any exhibit, exhibitor or competitor and agree that all competitions are under the complete and total control of the Townsville Pastoral Agricultural & Industrial Association whose decision in all matters is final.
2. For the duration of the Show all exhibits are in the total care of the Chief Stewards and will be fed and watered. The exhibits are not to be touched or handled by the owners or any other person other than the Judge or Stewards, under the supervision of the Chief Steward.
3. The Townsville Pastoral Agricultural & Industrial Association:-
  - (a) Will appoint a Chief Steward to each section as its representative.
  - (b) Will appoint Judges whose decisions are final.
  - (c) Reserve to right to make any changes to this schedule without further notice.
4. Entry fees must accompany entry forms. **USE ONE LINE FOR EACH ENTRY**; if entering two birds in one class please use **TWO LINES**. Use the entry form supplied, extra forms are available from the Show Office upon request.
5. No exhibit will be allowed to compete for more than one class and championship, **with no more than three (3) birds per class**.
6. Winners from Backyard Poultry & Schools Poultry Sections are ineligible for Grand Champion of Show.
7. Prizes can be withheld where, in the opinion of the Judges, exhibits are of insufficient merit. No second prize money will be paid where there are less than five (5) entries in a class.
8. Judging will commence at **9:00am sharp on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2025**. All exhibits must be penned by **8:00am Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2025**. The pavilion will be open from **6:30am on Saturday**. Birds may be penned between **12:30 pm and 4:30 pm on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2025 or on the day by 8:00am**.
9. The pavilion will be closed to the public at 8:30 pm on Saturday and Sunday and at 5:30pm on **Monday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2025** and exhibitors may collect their birds after this time. However, exhibitors living more than 50 km from Townsville may collect birds at any time after 3:00 pm if more convenient, or at Chief Stewards discretion.
10. "FOR SALE" CARDS OR NOTICES are not allowed on exhibits without approval of the Chief Steward.
11. Prize money/vouchers/trophies will be available for collection from the Administration Office from **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July** until **Friday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2025 between 9:00 - 4:00pm**. If exhibitors are unable to collect their prize money on the nominated day, arrangements can be made to have prize money directly deposited into their nominated bank account. Please ensure you complete you bank details on your entry form if EFT is your preferred payment option. Any prize money not collected by **Friday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2025** will be forfeited, unless arrangements are made between the dates of **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July and Friday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2025** for collection.
12. No sick, diseased, lice or stick fast flea infected birds to be accepted and will be removed from the pavilion and disqualified.
13. Eggs laid during the show shall be chipped but if required by the exhibitor, he/she must advise the Stewards beforehand and Provide egg carton with name on it.
